Call for Application for Master's Scholarship in Nuclear Engineering

Nuclear Reactor Technology Center of Excellence (NRT COE) of Addis Ababa Science and Technology University is looking for interested graduates of AASTU who want to study MSc in Nuclear Engineering Programs in top Korean universities: Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST), Seoul National University (SNU) and Ulsan National Institute of Science and Technology (UNIST). Full scholarship, including tuition and monthly living expenses according to each university's guideline, would be provided during the Master's Degree period for the successful candidates after screening and tests which will be given by Korean university professors. Successful students during the MS study may be given an opportunity to continue for Ph.D. study. Meanwhile for scholarship winners, NRT COE may arrange recruitment opportunities here in AASTU. Graduates of the under-listed BSc Programs with their CGPA distinction and above are cordially invited to participate in this competition based scholarship opportunity. The required background BSc programs and desirable specific qualifications are:

- *BSc in Electromechanical Engineering*
- *BSc in Mechanical Engineering*
- *BSc in Chemical Engineering*
- *BSc in Electrical Engineering (Power Eng. Stream)*
- *BSc in Industrial Chemistry*

N.B. Desirable qualification of the candidates are as follows:-

Area 1: Excellent scores and qualification in

1. Mathematics
2. Computer programming
3. English (TOEFL IBT, IELTS, TEPS, TOEIC or other Equivalent)
4. Physics

Area 2: Excellent scores and qualification in

1. Materials Science
2. Computer programming or Laboratory experiments skills
3. English (TOEFL IBT, IELTS, TEPS, TOEIC or other Equivalent)
4. Physics and Chemistry



Therefore, interested applicants need to register and submit their motivation letter and CV with copies of academic and English proficiency test (IELTS, TOEFL or Equivalent) records and other credentials to the Office of Vice President for Academic Affairs.
